NOTICE TO MARINERS **FIRTH OF FORTH**

SUBMERGED POWER AND DATA CABLES

- 1) The attached table records the locations of submerged power and data cables in docks and at berths on the Forth. These are in addition to main cables running across the Forth which are marked on the Admiralty charts.
- 2) Notices will be posted at these locations to warn mariners of the existence of submerged cables.
- 3) To avoid fouling and damaging these cables the use of anchors is prohibited in these areas.
- 4) The use of anchors should also be avoided in or approaching locks, cuts, drydocks, passages etc.
- 5) Status of Previously Published Notices
