RIVER TAY.

SPORTING AND RECREATION DESIGNATED AREAS

Ref. Dundee Port Authority (General) Byelaws 1984, No 67 (1) and (3)

Notice is hereby given that, in conjunction with Dundee City Council, a designated launching area, for persons engaged in launching jetskis, speedboats or other mechanically propelled watercraft, which must be rigidly adhered to by such persons, will shortly be set up in the vicinity of the slipway close east of Broughty Castle at Broughty Ferry Beach.

The area designated is as follows:

1. From the east end of the aforesaid slipway, a line to a red marker buoy in position $56^{\circ} 27.70'N$ $002^{\circ} 51.78'W$
2. From the west end of the aforesaid slipway, a line to a green marker buoy in position $56^{\circ} 27.72'N$ $002^{\circ} 51.94'W$, thence to a second green marker buoy in position $56^{\circ} 27.68'N$ $002^{\circ} 51.92'W$.

There will be a series of intermediate marker buoys defining the edges of the launching channel to assist users in keeping clear of the adjacent designated swimming area to the east, and the hazardous outfall riser to the west.

A chartlet showing the designated launching area is attached.
