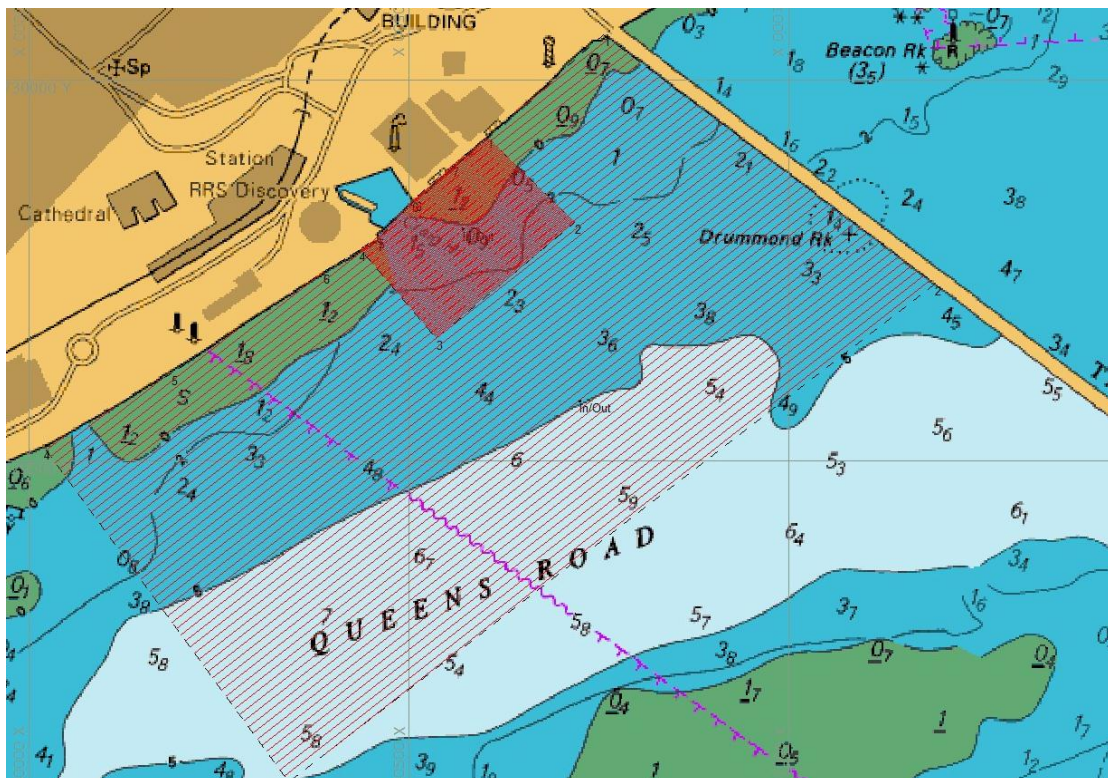
RIVER TAY

V&A MUSEUM SITE INVESTIGATION WORKS

(Admiralty Chart River Tay 1481)

Mariners are advised that commencing on or about the 16th January 2012, site investigation works will resume in the vicinity of Craig Harbour, North Bank, River Tay.

A geotechnical survey will take place over the inner hatched area 200 metres in length (SW-NE) and 150m seaward at 5m grid intervals.



This second phase will extend for a period of 53 days and subject to normal working and weather conditions will take place on a 12 hour / 7 day week basis. Surveys and boreholes will be carried out within a radius of approximately 150 metres from the following position 56°27.38'N 002° 57.93'W.

(National Grid Reference NO 405 298)

Operations will be carried out from the jack-up barge “SKATE 1”, dimensions 12.2m x 9.2m.

During the operations, ALL vessels involved will advise Dundee Harbour Radio (VHF Channel 12) of all their intended movements and will display the lights and signals required by the International Regulations and maintain a listening watch on VHF Channel 12.

Mariners are requested to keep well clear and navigate with caution, particularly when the rig is afloat and manoeuvring.
