# 3 PORTS

## DUNDEE

Strategically located on the east coast, midway between Aberdeen and the central belt of Scotland, the Port of Dundee is optimally positioned for fabrication, mobilisation and decommissioning projects for the North Sea oil and gas industry.

A designated heavy lifting facility, Dundee provides a complete onshore decommissioning and waste management solution.

The port's deepwater quays in sheltered waters incorporate extensive lay down and storage areas for dismantling.

Our adjacent 12.6 hectare storage and project area means that a very significant number of large modules can be accommodated and processed at once.

## LEITH

The Port of Leith is the largest enclosed deepwater port in Scotland. Its optimum location allows short transits offshore.

A key contributor to offshore oil and gas for a significant period of time, the port is an established base for CSV and DSV vessels. It is also home to the fully automated pipe handling system Leith Spoolbase, operated by Subsea 7, and is the base for leading pipecoating specialists, Bredero Shaw.

The port is ideally located for North Sea activities and has established a reputation for its reliable service and high quality offshore support facilities. Easy access to open quay storage and a maintained water level means that Leith is an ideal choice for mobilisation and demobilisation.

Top international oil and gas teams regularly choose Leith for a wide variety of projects due to the port's proximity to key fields, easy access to high quality staff and our on-port specialist oil and gas teams and supply chain partners.

## ROSYTH

The Port of Rosyth has established an impressive track record handling and processing large scale heavy lift projects, including in excess of 100, 750-tonne large steel deck sections for the new £1.4billion Forth crossing.

Rosyth has significant storage areas in close proximity to the quayside, enabling large structures and sections to be handled quickly and efficiently.

Centrally located on the north bank of the River Forth, Rosyth is a key gateway into Fife and provides easy access to the M90 and the main arterial motorway network.
