Grangemouth is Scotland's largest container terminal, handling over 250,000 TEUs each year. It is Scotland's largest feeder port.



The Port of Grangemouth's fully integrated container service means that UK shippers who use the Port are able to fully comply with the new international regulations.

Effective from 1st July 2016 the updated SOLAS (Safety of Life at Sea) Convention requires every export container carrying cargo to have its weight verified before it is loaded on to a ship.

We are equipped with an on-site registered weigh bridge - enabling SOLAS compliance.

Shipping in and out of our ports delivers proven green economic benefits. It cuts down the number of links in your supply chain. So road and rail congestion is reduced and low carbon connections become more efficient.

With experience in handling a wide variety of goods, regardless of your cargo, unitised or non-unitised, and out of gauge handling capabilities, we offer a one-stop sustainable logistics solution.

As part of our multi-million pound investment programme at Grangemouth we have recently invested in additional storage lanes for conventional and refrigerated containers, and improved access to landside and shipside operations.

Our efficient, highly trained and qualified team have the skills, experience and machinery on hand to safely, efficiently and speedily handle the loading and unloading of containers and vessels 24/7.
