Marine Notice to Port of Tilbury Users No.11 of 2012

COMPLETION OF PORT WASTE MANAGEMENT NOTIFICATION FORM.

Masters and their Agents are reminded that it is a statutory requirement to complete a waste notification IN FULL at least 24 hours prior to arrival at the Port of Tilbury, or on departure from previous port if less than 24 hours.

Incomplete notifications are not acceptable. The ship's Agency and or the Master will be contacted after arrival to re-submit notification to the Port's satisfaction. If the complete information is not received, The Port of Tilbury is obligated to inform the Maritime and Coastguard Agency (MCA). Such vessels may then be targeted by the MCA for inspection and destination ports will be warned of their non-compliance.

The Maritime and Coastguard Agency is aware that some notifications are not fully completed. Subsequently the MCA have highlighted this by issuing Marine Information Note, MIN 377, to the Industry. Please study this carefully and pass to all ship's which call to the Port of Tilbury under your Agency. For ease of reference it is attached to this notice together with a specimen of Waste Management Notification form.
