Notice to Mariners – No. 18 of 2012

BUNKERING

In view of recent Maritime and Coastguard Agency requirements, all bunkering and oily substance discharge from vessels at the Port of Tilbury will be subject to satisfactory completion of a “Marine operation checklist”. Until this point, no operation can or will commence.

This requirement applies to waterside transfers from tanker vessel / barge, or that by road tanker operation.

Application for authorisation should be made to Marine Department Duty Officer on 01375 852456 marine.department@potll.com

The Port will carry out the checklist when personnel are available, therefore the more notice that can be given the better.

Delays may be experienced if notice isn't given, for which the port cannot be held responsible for, therefore I would kindly ask that prior notice is given.
