



**Port of Tilbury (London) Ltd.
Notice to Mariners – No. 21 of 2017
Waste Notifications**

Mariners are reminded that The Merchant Shipping and Fishing Vessels **(Port Waste Reception Facilities) Regulations 2003** transpose the requirements of Directive 2000/59/EC of the European Parliament and Council on for reception facilities for ship-generated waste and cargo residues, as amended, into UK law. As per the 2003 Regulations it is a requirement for a vessel to notify the Harbour or Terminal in advance of arrival of the amount of waste to be discharged, including information on types and quantities.




As per Notice to Mariners No. 4 of 2013 all Shipping Agents are requested to input this data directly in to the Port of Tilbury “IPOS” system. This must be done not less than 24 hours before arrival or on departure of the last port if within 24 hours. This process is mandatory and failure to comply with it will incur in a £25 charge to cover admin cost.
