**NOTICE TO MARINERS**

**FIRTH OF TAY**

**Ensco 123 Large Vessel Movement Firth of Tay**

Mariners are advised that the jack-up drilling rig 'Ensco 123' is scheduled to depart from the Port of Dundee. The Ensco 123 will depart from King George V Wharf and proceed to Sea on Thursday 1<sup>st</sup> August at approximately 1200 BST and will take several hours to complete her transit to the Fairway Buoy. The rig will be assisted by 4 harbour tugs, and one larger lead tug, the 'Maersk Laser', off the bow.

The navigation channels will be closed for this planned movement to allow the safe navigation of the Ensco 123 and her towing vessels. All other vessels are required to keep well clear (minimum 200 metres all round) and must not impede or endanger the planned passage as per General Direction No 14.

The rig move is weather dependant, and Dundee Harbour Radio can be contacted on VHF channel 12 for any updates.

This notice will be self-cancelling on completion of the departure of the Ensco 123.
