NOTICE TO MARINERS

FIRTH OF TAY

Ensko 123 Large Vessel Movement Firth of Tay

Mariners are advised that the jack-up drilling rig 'Ensko 123' is due to arrive in the Port of Dundee on Thursday 09th January 2020. The rig will transit the Tay from Sea to King George V Wharf. The rig will arrive at the Fairway Buoy at approximately 0945 GMT and will take several hours to complete her transit to the berth. The rig will be assisted by 4 harbour tugs, and one larger lead tug, the 'Atlantic Kestrel', off the bow.

The navigation channels will be closed for this planned movement to allow the safe navigation of the rig and her towing vessels. All other vessels are required to keep well clear (minimum 200 metres all round) and must not impede or endanger the planned passage as per General Direction No 14.

The rig move is weather dependant, and Dundee Harbour Radio can be contacted on VHF channel 12 for any updates.

This notice will be self-cancelling on completion of the move of this vessel.
