NOTICE TO MARINERS

FIRTH OF TAY

Broughty Ferry Flood Prevention Scheme

The works contained within the notice are being managed by Dundee City Council. If there are any enquiries regarding these works then they should be directed to the Council.

Mariners are advised that commencing on or around the 11th May, construction works will commence on the Broughty Ferry Flood Prevention Scheme, in order to construct a new sea wall and terrace steps at Broughty Ferry, Dundee. These works will be carried out by McLaughlin & Harvey working from a temporary rock fill bund in the intertidal zone along the shore.

The timeframe for these works is expected to be approximately 24 months.

The Position of these works will be the shore west of Broughty Ferry Harbour in an area bounded by the Following Positions.
