NOTICE TO MARINERS FIRTH OF FORTH

GRANGE DOCK

GANTRY CRANE 6 BOOMS

Gantry Crane 6 (GC6) requires boom maintenance to be undertaken. This process will take approx. 3 days commencing 22^{nd} July.

During this 3 day period the gantry crane will be unable to lift its boom. To enable the remaining gantry cranes to have free range of movement on the container berth, GC6 will remain in its last box mark position (East) at bollard position 19.5 during works.

The Grangemouth Container Berth will operate on a 2 berth operation until works are complete. All vessels should ensure they are berthed no further East than Bollard 17.5 during these works.

Controlled communications via FTNS will ensure that personnel are clear of the crane for vessel movements within its vicinity.

Pilots / Masters are to dynamically assess conditions on the day and raise alternative tug and/or layby options with FTNS as appropriate.
