NOTICE TO MARINERS FIRTH OF TAY

Large Vessel Movement - Firth of Tay

Mariners are advised that the unpowered barge 'AMT Crusader' is due to arrive at the Port of Dundee under tow by the anchor handler 'MT Kamarina' and transit to Prince Charles Wharf on Friday 15 April 2022.

The barge will begin its approach at approximately 1130 BST and will take three hours to navigate to the berth. The barge will be assisted by 2 harbour tugs, with the ATH 'Kamarina' on the bow.

The navigation channels will be closed for this planned movement to allow the safe navigation of the barge and its towing vessels. All other vessels are required to keep well clear (minimum 200 metres all round) and must not impede or endanger the planned passage as per General Direction No 14.

The move is weather dependant, and Dundee Harbour Radio can be contacted on VHF channel 12 for any updates.

This notice will self-cancel at 15/16h00.
