Leith Outer Berth Project

Mariners are advised that on or around Saturday 11th February 2023, works on the Leith Outer Berth Project will commence. Works are expected to last a minimum of 12 months.



Numerous support craft will assist the project and shall regularly be within the vicinity of Leith Approaches and the Spoil Ground including during hours of darkness. All vessels / barges will display lights and shapes as per international regulations.

All support vessels involved in the project will monitor VHF channels 71, 12 and 16.

Vessels working on the outer berth project shall, with sufficient notice, move clear of the channel to allow shipping to enter / leave the dock. FTNS will ensure that all movements are planned accordingly.

Vessels transiting within the vicinity of Leith Approaches are to keep well clear of lead-in jetty.

During periods of the project it will be necessary to amend the requirements for towage, pilotage and lock transit times in the interest of safety of navigation. Any changes shall be promulgated via Notice to Mariners as well as on the [Procedures & Guidelines section of our website](#).
