

Permit To Manoeuvre Craft within the Ports Limits

This permit is issued in conjunction with Notices to Mariners No 22 of 2019.

This "Permit" has three sections:-

- 1. <u>Specific Persons</u> of which The Port of Tilbury recognises as Berthing Advisors
- 2. A vessel <u>less than 80m</u> in length
- 3. Persons Exempted from Berthing Assistance / Advice for a specific Vessel or Vessels

Note, The Chief Harbour Master or his nominated deputy can and will suspend or revoke a permit if it is deemed in the Ports interest to do so. This permit is valid for a period not exceeding one year, providing the supporting documentation remains valid. All Permit holders will report any Marine Incident using the report form found at https://www.forthports.co.uk/wp-content/uploads/2018/11/PMSC-Marine-Report-Form-Part-1.pdf
