NOTICE TO MARINERS

FIRTH OF FORTH

Survey Operations – Inner Firth

Mariners are advised that Aspect Land & Hydrographic Surveys Ltd (ALHS) will be conducting a multibeam bathymetric & side-scan sonar survey around the NG Feeder 12 pipeline, on the River Forth between 3rd & 14th November 2025.

The survey area, including 500m buffer zone, is defined below:

- o 466417.53 6207163.41 56° 0.513734'N 003° 32.314823'W
- o 466857.05 6206988.73 56° 0.421404'N 003° 31.890622'W
- o 468271.55 6210184.27 56° 2.149774'N 003° 30.552292'W
- o 467878.39 6210477.02 56° 2.306016'N 003° 30.932964'W



The vessel conducting the works will be restricted in its ability to manoeuvre and will display the appropriate lights and shapes. Other vessels are requested to pass at a safe speed and provide a minimum clearance of 500m during survey operations. The vessel will ensure FTNS are kept updated on movements and no survey operations will take place in the channel when commercial shipping traffic is transiting the area so as not to impede their safe passage.

The vessel will monitor VHF Channel 16 & 71 throughout survey operations.
